SAM's *Art to Go!* program introduces students of all ages to great works of art, important artists, and pivotal periods of art history in your own setting. Collections in the form of a portfolio of print reproductions and a corresponding binder provide an easy-to-use resource for arts programming for your school, community organization, home school group, retirement community, and more. Join us for an engaging workshop where you will be introduced to this innovative program and have an opportunity to take part in 'mock' learning sessions. Portfolios related to our current exhibit *Treasures from the Attic* will be featured. Workshop is limited to 15 participants.

Treasures from the Attic: Creating Memory Collages

From May 22 through September 21, 2008, the Susquehanna Art Museum will host ***Treasures from the Attic: Unseen Treasures from the Capital Region***, an exhibit that explores the unseen wealth in the permanent collections of regional institutions. ***Treasures from the Attic*** will showcase a collection of works removed from the public eye for decades and, in some cases, centuries. The variety of pieces ranges from a 1775 scenic view of Harrisburg to creations by modern masters from Europe and the United States. Romare Bearden, Jacob Eichholtz, Stephen Etnier, Thomas Moran, Red Grooms, Jacob Lawrence, Robert Rauschenberg and Gustave Courbet are a few of the artists to be featured in the exhibition. The exhibit will provide information about the intriguing history of the loaning institutions and collections.

A guided gallery tour of SAM's current exhibit will begin the day, followed by a workshop where participants will use basic paper techniques and design instruction to create a 'memory' collage based on their own photographs, ephemera, or art; a wide collection of collage materials will be at your disposal during this workshop. After lunch on your own, participants will have time to put the finishing touches on their own personal 'treasure'. Scrapbook enthusiasts will especially enjoy this workshop. Act 48 hours will be awarded, and adaptations for students with special needed will be discussed.

Space is limited. Please RSVP no later than 2 weeks prior to date of workshop by using the form below.
